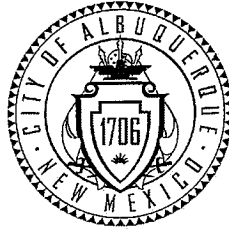

Environmental Planning Commission

NOTICE

On 10 December 2009 the Environmental Planning Commission (EPC) voted to amend their Rules Of Conduct (A. Organization and Meetings) to change the day of their regular public hearing. The language now reads as follows:

“2. Regular public hearings on current land use applications shall be on the *second* Thursday of each month. In the event such a day is a public holiday, the hearing shall be exactly one week later. Special meetings, including hearings, may be scheduled by the EPC Chair at other times when necessary provided that notice is given. Unless otherwise posted, meetings shall be in the Plaza del Sol Hearing Room, Lower Level, 600 2nd Street NW.” [emphasis added]

Please note that this change of the regular EPC hearing day from the third Thursday of each month to the **SECOND** Thursday of each month begins with the March 2010 public hearing date (the hearing date on 18 February 2010 remains with a submittal deadline of 07 January 2010). This new hearing date schedule has resulted in a corresponding, administrative change to the application deadline for EPC submittals. Beginning with the March 2010 hearing date, the new application deadline will be the last Thursday of each month at Noon for the EPC hearing 42-49 days later. 
Dear Mr. Reiselt:

The Judges of the Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court would like to extend an invitation to you to learn more about the busiest court in the state of New Mexico. Our Judges are happy to come to your neighborhood association meeting to make presentations, talk about Court procedures, the issues facing the Court and answer questions. We welcome opportunities to address your concerns or to simply educate your members about the function of the Court and how it serves this community.

The 19 Judges of the Metropolitan Court preside over more than 125,000 cases a year, more than any other court in New Mexico. The Court has staff working seven days a week and 24 hours a day. Judges preside over a variety of cases, including DWI cases (up to a third offense), certain domestic violence cases; non-DWI and domestic violence cases including resisting arrest, shoplifting, assault, battery, civil matters (up to a \$10,000 limit) and landlord-tenant disputes. There is a lot going on with the Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court!
